What is the difference between Outreach/Invite & Evangelism

- Most church based outreach revolves around reaching out to invite in (very needful)
- Is this all Christ called us to do?
- Evangelism is: the spreading of the Gospel by preaching, personal witness, conversion, etc...
- **It is important to make sure all outreach includes evangelism, otherwise it is not truly fulfilling the Great Commission!**

Appearance

How are you and/or your team dressed?

- Casual is often best
- Sometimes young Christians like to get involved, so be sure to establish a dress standard for your team ahead of time.
- Neat & clean
- Weather appropriate
- No hairy situations - neat.... (wind exception)

Tracts


- **Visual:**
 - Easy to read, not too complicated
 - Relative Graphics
 - Good Sizes
- Read what you hand out! (Is it doctrinally sound?)
- Know what is in it. Is the content accurate?
- If possible, use informative explanation when handing it out.
- Say things like:
 - "May I share one of these with you"
 - "Did you get one yet"
 - "Check this out"
 - Sometimes your action is based on which tract you have
- Find what works for you



- Scripture on at least one side:
 - Easy to read, not too complicated
 - Good Sizes
- Non-Scripture Signs, Be led of the Lord!
- How far away can they read them?
- Can they be read at night

First Encounters

- Forget your fear, allow God to fill your mouth
As you get busy, fear can be shrugged off
- Find your ice breakers: humor, something about them you can see or relate too, tracts and prayer
- Goal: Work towards sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ (At least give them a Gospel Tract)
- When possible, get to how to be saved:
1. Confess 2. Repent 3. Believe

Spontaneous Evangelism

Luke 13:22 "And He went through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Jerusalem."

Jesus evangelized everywhere went. He made ministry happen. He did not just preach meetings. He share with the one by the well too...

Be Like Jesus, Everywhere you go, be prepared for opportunities to share the Gospel

Who is standing by the well you go to for water? Share the Gospel as you go about your journey of life.

PRAYER STAND EVANGELISM

- Meet them on their way to the prayer stand. Don't wait for them to stop to talk to you.
- Try to pass them a Gospel tract as you inquire if they need prayer.
- Ask if you may pray for them or their family
- If they have no desire for prayer, politely bid them a good day.
- Desire prayer, get specific requests, then lead in prayer, followed by sharing the Gospel message of salvation.
- Always good to conclude prayer for their salvation in a tactful way. The late Sister Myrtle Reed (Sally Sebo's grandmother), had a wonderful non-offending way of doing that by ending her prayers with "and God please bless them redemptively."

Door-to-Door Evangelism

Goal of Each Visit

- ▶ You have Divine Appointments waiting!
 - Not a matter of if God will, it is a matter of When God will win somebody through you!
- 1. Show Concern for them in your Intro and offer to pray
 - a. Say something like: "Hi My name is _____, I am concerned about our community, and I was wondering if there is something I can pray about for you or your family?"
 - b. If they are interested in prayer, pray for them
 - c. Whether they were interested in prayer or not, move on to present the Gospel

2. Share the Gospel and way of salvation

a. What is the Gospel?

Often, we think of the Gospel as the method to lead someone to Christ, but that is evangelism or the plan of salvation.

We, knowing the Gospel take it for granted that everybody knows who Jesus is.

2. Share the Gospel and way of salvation

a. What is the Gospel? The Gospel is:

1 Corinthians 15:1-8 KJV 1 Moreover, brethren, **I declare unto you the gospel** which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; 2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain, 3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how **that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures; 5 And that he was seen** of Cephas, then of the twelve: 6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep. 7 After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles. 8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

Goal of Each Visit

2. Share the Gospel and way of salvation

a. What is the Gospel? The Gospel is:

Luke 24:46-49 KJV 46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: 47 **And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations**, beginning at Jerusalem. 48 And ye are witnesses of these things. 49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you; but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

So we need to present Christ death and resurrection for the remission of sins And this only comes through confession and true repentance. (The way of salvation is covered in our session on Successful Soul Winning at: EvangelismMission.com/videos/soulwinning)

2. Share the Gospel

a. What is the Gospel? The Gospel is:

b. By word of mouth, building from their prayer request

c. At the very least share a tract

- i. Be sensitive to know what tract to give them, listen for the leadership of the Holy Spirit
- ii. Tract appropriate for their age group

Goal of Each Visit

3. Invite to a special service, (remember every service is special when God is there. Tell them God will be there!)

Have a flyer ready to hand them

Reviewing the 3 points:

1. Concern (prayer)
2. Gospel
3. Invite
4. Get contact info of interested people (see cards)

POINTERS FOR OPEN AIR PREACHING

1. Be filled with God's Spirit

2. Be Courageous!

3. Be Loving

4. Be Kind

5. Be Bold

6. Be Brief in your points

People pass by every 20 secs to a few minutes

Long Stories are often only heard in sections

7. Be thorough!

Preach against Sin, but be sure to share the remedy

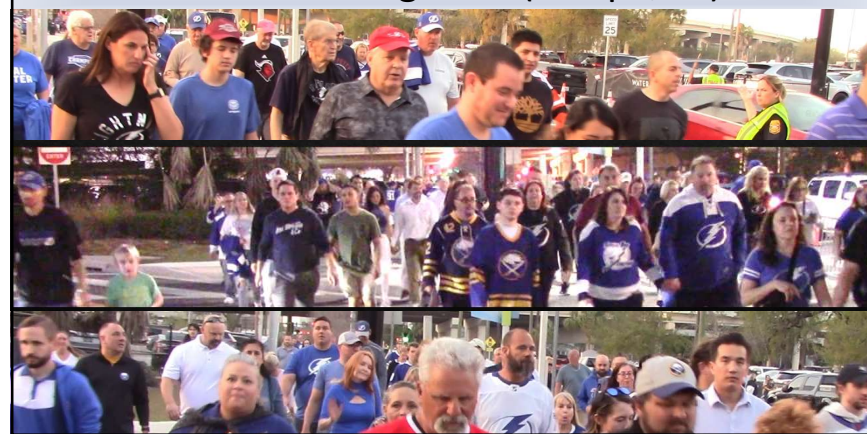
